Kwaggafontein is a rural area located a few hours outside of Gauteng Johannesburg in the province of Mapumalanga. Kwa is an area riddled and ravished with poverty. Our third Impact Kids School is located in Kwa and all of the children who attend are from this rural area. This is our first school in a rural area as opposed to an informal settlement! Kwa is home to about 45,104+ residents, of which many are children. Statistics show that many of the residents are unemployed, sick and a majority of the children are uneducated.

#### Country

The Republic of South Africa is a country in the southern region of Africa. South Africa is a multi-ethnic nation with diverse cultures, representing 11 official languages. Johannesburg is one of the most beautiful cities; however, just around the corner you will find many squatter camps scattered throughout. Approximately 450 children every day are orphaned in areas like these due to HIV/AIDS. The harsh realities of squatter camp life breed hopelessness and despair. With your help, Ziyanda will be learning and experiencing God's love in a safe environment!
